

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

For Seton Hall University Welfare Benefit Program

This is a summary of the annual report of the Seton Hall University Welfare Benefit Program, EIN 22-1500645, Plan No. 505, for the period January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Seton Hall University has committed itself to pay certain health and employee assistance program claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company and affiliates and Hartford Life and Accident to pay health, dental, vision, life insurance and accidental death and dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2014 were \$12,610,959.
